



COMPANY FACT FILE

- Arc-Gen was established in 1986 supplying the construction industry with mobile generators – a number of which are still operational today!
- Its first customer was Hember Plant in Warrington
- Today, Arc-Gen supplies a full range of premium mobile generators, welders, lighting towers and plasma cutters to the construction industry and tool hire companies
- In September 2006 the company was acquired by Shrewsbury-based Morris & Company (a top 500 privately owned business)
- Following consolidation of the plant hire sector, Arc-Gen acquired water pump and pressure washer manufacturer, Hilti TW, from the Flowplant Group in April 2008
- Arc-Gen currently employs 27 people from its headquarters at Four Ashes, Wolverhampton in the West Midlands
- Arc-Gen also has an office and workshop in Perth, Scotland
- The company is headed up by chief executive Mark Hodgkins who is also a director of Morris company and supported by sales director Andy Munford
- In 2002 Arc-Gen was accredited with ISO 9001
- In February 2008 Arc-Gen won the Executive Hire Trade Show's environmental 'Green Zone Award' for its Weldmaker 300AVC
- The company is continuing to take the environment lead by extending its range of Super Silent generators which are up to 15db (A) quieter than the average – making them some of the quietest available in the UK
- Arc-Gen's Vertitower is the brightest, lightest and narrowest mobile lighting tower in Europe
